

DEMOGRAPHICS

2010 U.S. Census Data for the Village of Hoffman Estates as well as 2000 U.S. Census Data for the Village of Hoffman Estates were utilized as the primary source of data. Overall, the variance between the Park District boundaries and the Village of Hoffman Estates' boundaries is approximately net 1,380 additional residents within the Park District boundaries.

Demographics provide an overview of the residents that we primarily serve as well as characteristics unique to our residents. In addition, comparisons over time provide an overview of how our residents and characteristics have changed over time. Three primary sources of information were used to compile and document the demographic profile of Hoffman Estates. These include:

- (1) where 2010 date is noted, represents the U.S. Bureau of Census of 2010;
- (2) where 2000 date is noted, represents the U.S. Bureau of Census of 2000;
- (3) where 2008-2012 dates are noted, represents the U.S. Census American Community Survey which is U.S. Census data averaged over the period of time (i.e., data is derived by dividing the difference between April 1, 2008 estimate and April 1, 2012 estimate).

Census data does not exist specifically for the HEPD boundaries as census data is collected on the City, County, State and National levels.

Extensive Census data is available for the Village of Hoffman Estates' boundaries.

The boundaries of the Hoffman Estates Park District are approximately 95% coterminous with the Village of Hoffman Estates. Variances between the two units of government include:

HEPD boundaries not in Village of Hoffman Estates:

- South of Golf Road between Southbridge Lane and Cherry Lane, just west of Walnut and Knollwood Drive, north to Bode Road. Area is within the Village of Schaumburg and has approximately 1,300 households and 2,275 residents with approximately half within the Sheffield Townhomes (595) where the HEPD leases approximately 1 acre of property where Sheffield Park is located.
- North of Shoe Factory to I-90 between Bridlewood Drive and Shotkoski Drive, known as the Bridlewood Subdivision. The area is located within unincorporated Cook County and has approximately 200 single family homes with approximately 700 residents.

Village Boundaries not within HEPD Boundaries

- East of Treaty Lane (Beerman Farm) east of Ela Road to Regent, north of Algonquin in Highland Woods subdivision. Area has approximately 110 single family homes with approximately 385 residents.
- North of Palatine Road, south of Bradwell between Tarington on the east and Castaway to the west, Castaway Subdivision, within Palatine Park District boundaries. Area has approximately 230 single family homes with approximately 805 residents.
- North of Palatine Road, south of Bradwell between Tamarack and Thornbark Drive in the Evergreen subdivision, within Palatine Park District boundaries. Area has approximately 100 single family homes with approximately 350 residents.

Overall, the variance between the Park District and Village is approximately net 1,380 additional residents within the Park District than in the Village, which according to 2010 Census data would provide the Hoffman Estates Park District with an estimated population of 53,275.

Hoffman Estates, IL

Hoffman Estates has 20.80 square miles of land area and 0.18 square miles of water area. As of 2010, according to the U.S. Census, the total Hoffman Estates population is 51,895, which has grown 4.85% since 2000. The population growth rate is higher than the state average rate of 3.31% and is lower than the national average rate of 9.71%. Hoffman Estates median household income is \$81,105 in 2008-2012 and has grown by 23% since 2000. The income growth rate is about the same as the state average rate of 22.03% and is lower than the national average rate of 26.32%. Hoffman Estates median house value is \$270,100 in 2008-2012 and has grown by 48.65% since 2000. The house value growth rate is higher than the state average rate of 45.87% and is lower than the national average rate of 51.67%. As a reference, the national Consumer Price Index (CPI) inflation rate for the same period is 26.63%.

The Hoffman Estates population density is 2,473.93 people per square mile, which is much higher than the state average density of 221.55 people per square mile and is much higher than the national average density of 81.32 people per square mile. The most prevalent race in Hoffman Estates is white, which represent 64.11% of the total population, followed by Asian at 22.66% and Hispanics at 14.06%. By ancestry, the top three rankings include German (16.58%), Polish (13.20%) and Irish (10.43%). Predominate languages spoken at home include English (59.41%), Other Indo-European languages (17.51%), Spanish (11.44%), Asian and Pacific Islander languages (10.92%). Overall 70% speak English, while 9% speak only Spanish.

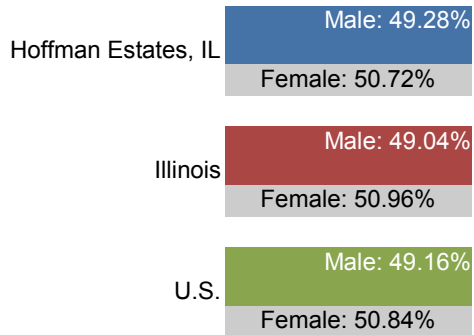

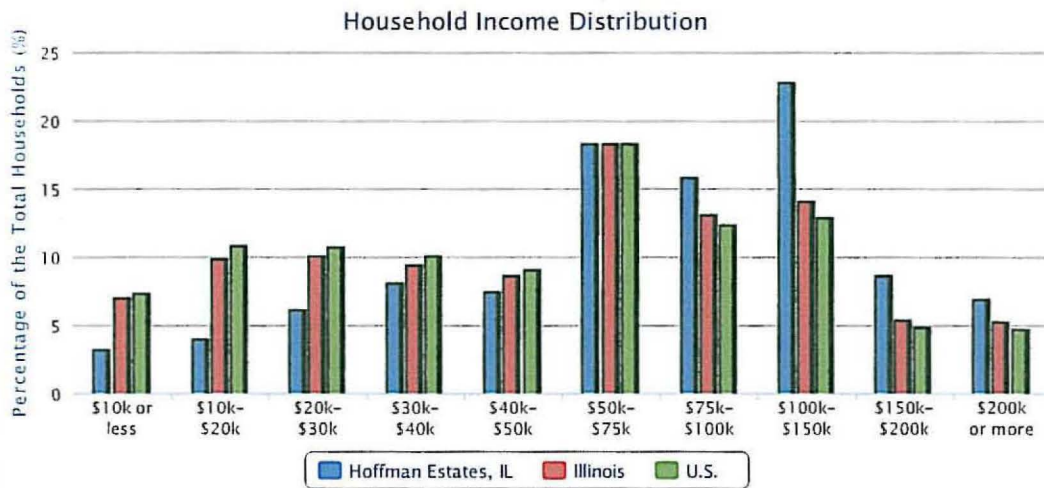

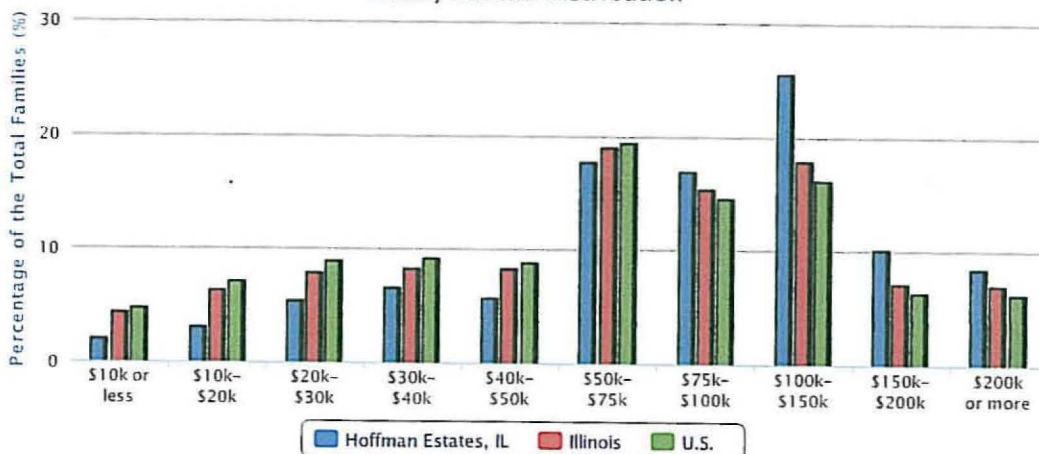

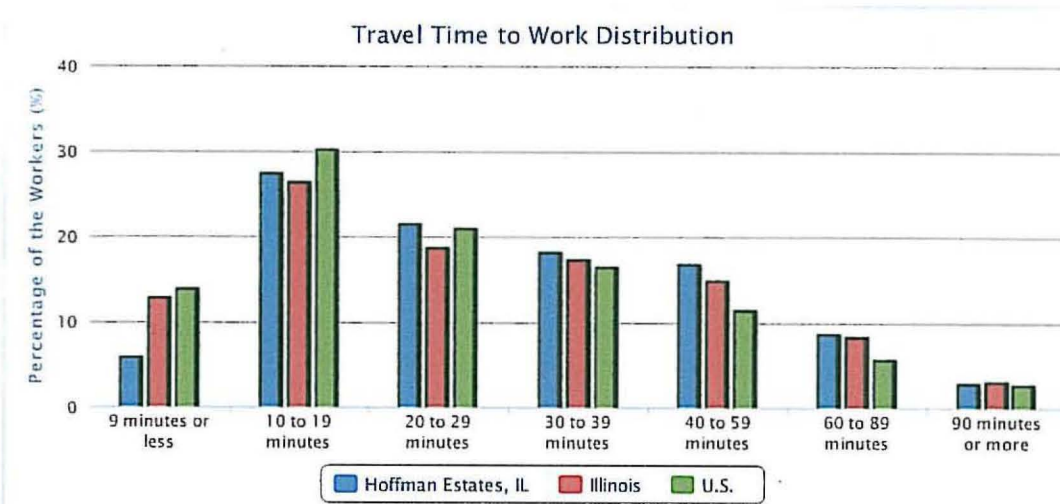

As of 2008-2012, median price of a house in Hoffman Estates is \$270,100, which is higher than the state average of \$190,800 and is higher than the national average of \$181,400. The Hoffman Estates median house value has grown by 48.65% since 2000. The growth rate for the price of a house in Hoffman Estates is higher than the state average rate of 45.87% and is lower than the national average rate of 51.67%. 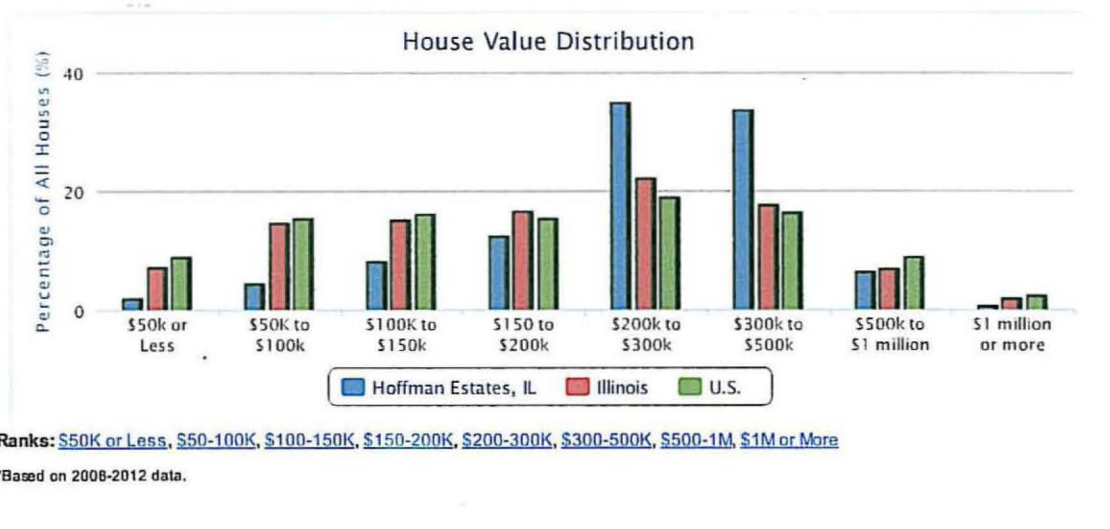

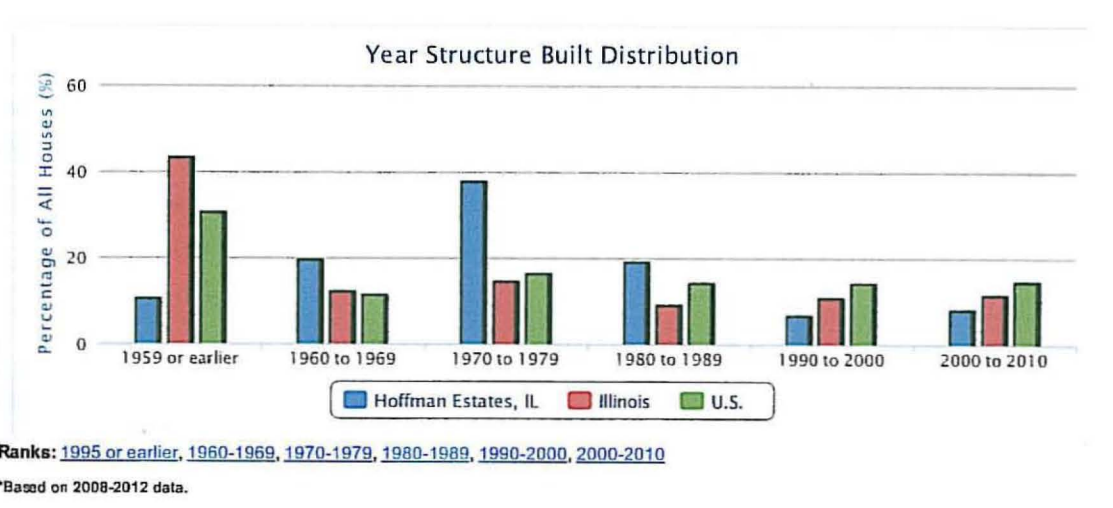

Hoffman Estates 2000 vs. 2010

General Population Demographic Overview Changes

A comparative overview of 2000 Census data vs. 2010 Census data provides an insight into how our demographics have changed and how our demographics is trending for the future.

While the 2010 Profile and 2000 Profile do not provide an exact comparison of data, the more detailed data can be grouped to provide an apples to apples comparison.

Overall population increased from 49,495 to 51,895 or 4.85% in 2010.

In 2000, ages 19 and under: 15,162 representing 30.6% of the population.

In 2010, ages 19 and under: 14,168 representing 27.4% of the population, representing a decrease of 7.02%.

In 2000, ages 35-54: 16,750 representing 33.8% of the population.

In 2010, ages 35-54: 16,074 representing 31.0% of the population, representing a decrease of 4.20%.

In 2000, ages 55+: 6,929 representing 14.1% of the population.

In 2010, ages 55+: 11,338 representing 21.7% of the population, representing an increase of 63.63%.

Overall, the median age increased from 33.6 years of age in 2000 to 37.0 years of age in 2010.

Changes in race:

In 2000, White: 36,837, representing 74.4% of the population.

In 2010, White: 33,270, representing 64.1% of the population, representing a decrease of 10.72%.

In 2000, Asian: 7,461 representing 15.1% of the population.

In 2010, Asian: 11,760 representing 22.7% of the population, representing an increase of 57.62%.

Of the 11,760 Asians, 5,738 or 48.79% were Asian Indian, followed by 1,514 or 12.87% Korean and 1,369 or 11.64% Pilipino.

In 2000 Hispanic/Latino: 5,198 representing 10.5% of the population.

In 2010 Hispanic/Latino: 7,297 representing 14.1% of the population, representing an increase of 40.38%.

Within the Hispanic/Latino 2010 Census, 5,522 or 75.67% of the 7,297 were Mexican, followed by 584 or 8.0% Puerto Rican.

In 2000 Black or African American: 2,166 representing 4.4% of the population.

In 2010 Black or African American: 2,478 representing 4.8% of the population, representing an increase of 14.40%.
